

Did you know?

....every child who transitions from intensive ABA programming with typical functioning will save taxpayers between 1.7 and 3.0 million in the cost of lifelong services.¹

CLC's first student returned to public school in 2008 and a second child is transitioning now.

....even those who realize only partial effects of ABA intervention and still require some assistance save taxpayers over one million dollars in lifetime services.²

Our oldest student (19) began working part-time in January earning \$10.00/hr.

....The cost of a local residential placement and day program providing minimal vocational training for students with autism is \$187,975 per year.

CLC's program trains students in the life skills they need to care for themselves, stay with their families, and participate and work in the community.

Creating Futures

Since 2000, the Comprehensive Learning Center has been helping children with autism develop the independence and skills they need to succeed.

CLC's programs prepare children for transition to typical school programs, community activities and meaningful work by age 21. This greatly decreases the cost of their long term care and offers our children the opportunity to help support themselves when they reach adulthood.

Why expand?

CLC's success in helping children with autism achieve has led to a greater demand for its services. We currently have 170 children on a waiting list for consideration but our current facility is at capacity.

We have leased a new building, currently under construction adjacent to our present location, that will provide an additional 6,000 sq. ft. of space. This will offer greatly improved vocational and life-skills teaching environments and provide space to grow our program for the next decade.

The new building will provide:

- A new kitchen/dining room and laundry room for teaching home living skills
- A Vocational Training 'Office' for teaching clerical and computer skills
- Additional Classroom Space to ease over-crowding and allow for future growth
- A gymnasium for teaching physical and play skills year round
- A large conference room with AV equipment for meetings, training and hosting visitors
- Space for the addition of an adult life-skills program to provide employment training and job coaching into adulthood

Our goal is to raise \$200,000 toward our expansion expenses.
